## Picasa: collages, slideshows, and movies

Picasa is free from <a href="http://picasa.google.com">http://picasa.google.com</a>



put them in a folder on your Desktop, call it something like "photos"

inside your "photos" folder, make a new folder for 5-10 of your favorites—call it "faves" or something

## open MS Picture Manager

(Start > Programs > Microsoft Office > Microsoft Office Tools > MS Office Picture Manager) edit your pictures

crop

brighten automatically

adjust contrast or brighten manually

save edited pics into your "faves" folder

import the pictures from your "faves" folder

Select Device > Folder, then browse to "faves"

make a folder, call it something like "faves", and put your "faves" pics inside

**make a collage** from the pics in your "faves" folder

- try resize, rotate, remove, bring to top, scramble collage, and shuffle,
- when you have something you like, click the "Create Collage" button on the bottom left

**make a slideshow** from the pics in your "faves" folder

make a movie from the pics in "faves"

Movie tab

try the pan-and-fade option

tell it to zero in on the faces

Slide tab

select the font, size, and template

play it by hitting the green arrow, then when you have something you like, hit Create Movie
