What is EdReady? EdReady lets students test themselves in math, then helps them with a customized study path.

How much does it cost? Nothing! EdReady is available free to Oregon schools.

- College Math Readiness

Teachers – How to Get Started

Step 1: Get an Ed Ready Teacher Account

- Email support@orvsd.org and request an Ed Ready Teacher Account. Include the following information:
 - Your Name
 - Your school or district email address
 - Identify that you need a teacher account
 - Which test(s) you would like to have made available for your students
- You will receive an email from support@orvsd.org once your account is set up. It will include your temporary password

Step 2: Log in

- Log in to <http://oregon.edready.org>
- The first time you log in you will be prompted to change your password.
- Once you log in select :

Edit EdReady Version: Oregon Department of Education

Step 3: Create an Assessment

Create New Assessment

1. In the Assessments tab select
2. Select the option titled “Or start with a pre-loaded assessment for math?”

3. Select an Assessment you want to use and click on “Clone”
 4. This will give you the Assessment window with 4 tabs.
- Step 4: Customize your Assessment

1. In the General Information Tab :



- Name the Assessment something that works for you – eg. 2015 5th Period
- Click “Save”

2. In the Resources Tab:



- **Recommended:** Under the “**Excluded resource collections**” – select each item in the drop down menu and click “Include” until there are no more items left.

3. Optional: In the Scope and Initial Diagnostics Tabs:




- You can modify the topics that are available to the students

Step 5: Set up a Goal

1. Get back to the main tab set by selecting “EdReady Version Assessments”



2. Select Goals Tab




3. Select “Create New Goal”

Fill in the General Information. Make sure Access Type is “Private” and Goal

Type is “EdReady”. Click

4. Add an Assessment to the Goal. Click on the “Assessments” tab



- On the list of Available Assessments, find the assessment you want to use with this goal and select “Add”
