➤ **Fabulous Staff**

Staff member (Ray Robison) is very well-versed in all aspects of processing and reserving materials, sending mailings throughout our service area, and providing staff with resources. He is available by phone, email or in-person from Monday-Friday, 7:30-4:30. You will always reach a live-human when you call our media library during service hours.

➤ **Multi-Media Resources**

Access to over 14,000 pieces of multimedia content including software, DVD and VHS (many available in Spanish), kits with print and non-print materials, audio cassettes, literature books with tapes, a variety of books (some literature sets), other nonfiction books, models, 2 portable planetariums, life-sized skeletons, poster sets that are cataloged and available to check out using MEDIANET, our online catalog system.

➤ **Digital Content**

Content from Learn360 digital content subscription. Access to over 48,000 digital audio, images, documents and full-length video and video clips available 24/7 that allows users to download, stream content from their desktop computer. In addition to the Learn360 subscription content, there are 750 SOESD purchased digital videos that have come from user requests and high usage in other formats.

➤ **Subscription Databases**

In addition to a subscription to the Learn360 digital content, the SOESD Media Library has subscribed to "K-12 Teaching and Learning Center" for all teachers in our service area and the "World Book Online Reference Center Complete Suite", which includes the "World Book Discover", "World Book Advanced", "World Book Student", "World Book Kids" and "Enciclopedia Estudiantil Hallazgos" and "Early World of Learning". This subscription is available to all K-12 teachers and students and has home access.

➤ **Professional and Staff Development Resources**

A professional multimedia-library of over 500 resources, which has a variety of curricular as well as staff development materials and is located in the SOESD Media Library. All materials are available for checkout and are cataloged in our online catalog.

➤ **United States Postal Service and Courier Service to Area Schools**

The agency's USPS mail service, as well as specialty shippers such as FED-EX and UPS. This includes daily mail service as well as mail via the 3 ESD courier routes.

➤ **Outreach Programs by a Licensed Media Specialist**

A variety of outreach programs provided by Kate Weber, Instructional Materials Specialist. Training and information on the SOESD website is available for a variety of topics including: copyright issues, professional development for librarians in the SOESD's service areas, training on using our online catalog (MEDIANET), training on how to access our digital content (LEARN360) and trainings on how to utilize the OSLIS website which includes a subscription to databases that are available to schools state-wide. A librarians' listserv is an important information dissemination resource. This listserv currently has 100+ members from our three-region service area.

➤ **Textbook Adoption Reviewing**

Again this year the SOESD Media Library is providing access and review time for our area school districts to review the current materials for the Oregon State Textbook adoptions for this year. The content area up for adoption for 2013-2014 will be English Language Arts to help support the Common Core State Standards
